

Bay Area Funding Opportunities in the Transportation Funding Package

Solutions for Congested Corridors

10-Year: \$2.5 billion Annual: \$250 million

This new competitive program is for projects designed to achieve a balanced set of transportation, environmental, and community access improvement within highly congested travel corridors throughout the state and that are part of a comprehensive corridor plan. Projects that could be eligible for funding through this program include:

- I-680 (Contra Costa County) Livorna Road/Rudgear Road to Alcosta Boulevard
- I-80 (Solano County) Red Top Road to Air Base Parkway
- I-880 (Alameda County) between Oakland and Milpitas
- SR-84 (Alameda County) Dumbarton Bridge Westbound Approach
- SR-92 (Alameda County) San Mateo Bridge Westbound Approach
- I-680 (Contra Costa County) From Milpitas to Pleasanton, Northbound
- SR-237 EB (Santa Clara County) 1st St to Mathilda Ave
- SR-237 WB (Santa Clara County) Dixon Landing Road (880) to US101
- I-880 (Alameda County) Hegenberger Road/Lewelling Boulevard to SR-237
- I-680 (Contra Costa County) Benicia Bridge to Rudgear Road I-680 (Contra Costa County) Walnut Creek, Northbound
- I-80 (Alameda County) between Carquinez Bridge and Emeryville
- I-80 (Solano County) Air Base Parkway to I-505
- I-80 (Solano County) between Carquinez Bridge and Vallejo I-880 (Alameda County) San Leandro to Oakland, Northbound
- SR-85 (Santa Clara County) between Mountain View and San Jose

- I-680 (Contra Costa County) Walnut Creek to Benicia Bridge Northbound
- I-80 (Solano County) between Fairfield and Vallejo
- I-580 (Alameda County) Livermore to Tracy
- I-680 (Alameda County) San Ramon to Sunol
- I-680 (Solano County) Fairfield to Benicia
- I-80 (Solano County) Davis to Vacaville
- US 101 (Santa Clara County) Palo Alto to Morgan Hill

Trade Corridor Enhancement Funding

10-Year: \$3 billion Annual: \$300 million

Both local agencies and the state may nominate corridor-based freight projects for this funding. Projects that could be eligible for funding through this program include:

- Global Opportunities at the Port of Oakland (GoPort) / 7th Street Grade Separation Project

Self-Help Counties Funding

10-year: \$2 billion Annual: \$200 million

Counties that have voter approved taxes for transportation purposes will receive additional revenue for improvements to their transportation system.
